STATE BLAZER POLICY



Last Updated: 19 October 2023

1. Introduction

This policy is to detail the eligibility criteria, personalization options and ordering process for members of the Western Australian Rowing Community who wish to order a Rowing WA Blazer, and the associated representative pockets and embroidery.

2. BLAZER ELIGIBILITY

The following groups of people are eligible to purchase a Rowing WA Blazer:

- WA State Team Members competing in Open Events, they must have raced in the boat i.e. not reserve.
- WA State Team Coach Principal Coach of a State Team for a minimum of 3 years. (does not have to be consecutive years)
- WA Olympic and Paralympic athletes or coaches including past athletes and coaches
- Life Members including past members
- WA Masters State Team Member competed at a Masters Interstate Event, they must have raced in the boat i.e. not reserve.
- Boat Race Officials minimum service of 5 years at Level 2
- Board Members after completion of one full term (i.e. 3 years) including past members
- Key Volunteers (where approved by the Board from time-to-time)
- Rowing WA Staff (full time only after 1 year) cost covered by Rowing WA

3. POCKET IMAGERY

The Rowing WA Blazer will be produced in two variations, differentiated by the breast pocket image:



State Blazer

For all eligible recipients, excluding State Team members and coaches, and Life members



State Team Blazer

Eligibility for the WA State Team Swan image is limited to WA Interstate Senior Team Members and Coaches (including past members and coaches) and Life members. The WA State Team emblem will be sewn on post-production for eligible members.

4. POCKET EMBROIDERY

Embroidery is available on Rowing WA Blazers, on the left chest pocket under the image, for eligible members, to recognize achievements within the sport of rowing in WA.

All embroidery will be in red.

A winning Open Representative crew member will have a wreath with the year embroidered on the pocket.

5. Ordering Process

Rowing WA will coordinate the ordering of blazers from the approved RWA Blazer supplier and any associated embroidery. Ordering will be conducted annually, or as required, with the cost advised prior to the ordering window opening. The approx. cost of blazers is \$350-\$400 each (dependent on size, style, pocket image and embroidery, and subject to material and manufacturing price escalation).

Order requests will be completed via the Rowing WA website including Blazer eligibility confirmation, embroidery wording, sizing information, jacket style, etc.

Following placement of an order, Rowing WA will confirm:

- your Blazer eligibility (or request further information to confirm such eligibility)
- Blazer pocket and embroidery details
- Final Blazer cost (based on current production costs and embellishments)
- Approx. production timeline
- Any other relevant information
